To transition to NAATI Certification for free



NAATI certification is the new industry standard for working as a translator or interpreter out in the community.

<u>Transitioning to NAATI certification does not mean you will lose your existing</u> <u>NAATI accreditation or recognition.</u>

The last day you can transition to NAATI certification without paying a fee is **30** June **2018**. After this date, you will need to pay the **\$121 administration fee**.

Certification will bring about improved NAATI services for you including:

- Free listing on the online directory;
- A reduced recertification fee of \$198 (the former revalidation fee was \$242);
- New tools to self-manage your credential (e.g. electronic recertification logbooks); and
- A new streamlined online application process if you want to gain additional certifications.

WHY TRANSITION?

The transition process is very simple and straightforward.

If your accreditation (or recognition) has an expiry date, all you need to do is:

- 1. fill out the application form; and
- 2. attach a passport-style photo when you send it in.

If your accreditation (or recognition) does <u>not have</u> an expiry date, all you need to do is:

- 1. fill out the application form;
- 2. attach evidence of your work experience over the last three years or a statement as to why you have not; and
- 3. attach a passport-style photo when you send it in.
